Today (12/12), we toured up Republic creek and found roughly 6 inches of low density snow that fell over night without wind which was a nice treat. We dug a pit on a East aspect at 9200 feet and found a stable, right side up snowpack giving us an ECTN. Some small facets were found on the ground but we're none reactive in our tests. We didn't find the layered snowpack iv been finding near Bozeman. The cliff faces were shedding some sluff as we got into the alpine.
