Most started as spindrift in the cliff bands along the ridge and gained more snow as they fell into the aprons. Skied a north and southfacing couloir, ski cut at the top of both runs and got the new snow to sluff most of the way down. Didn't encounter any cohesive slabs, just lots of sluff sliding down."
