"There was a large, deep slab avalanche snowboard triggered in Lone Lake Cirque this afternoon. The slide ripped in a secondary start zone below ridgetop, and ran far into the flats, and may have run a bit uphill, where it encountered the rock glacier moraine in the runout. It looks to be a R4, D2.5."
